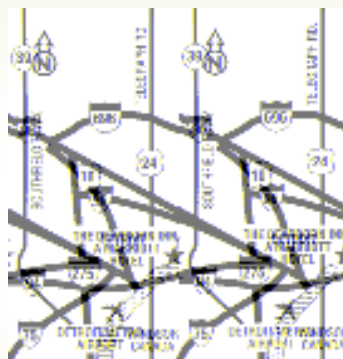
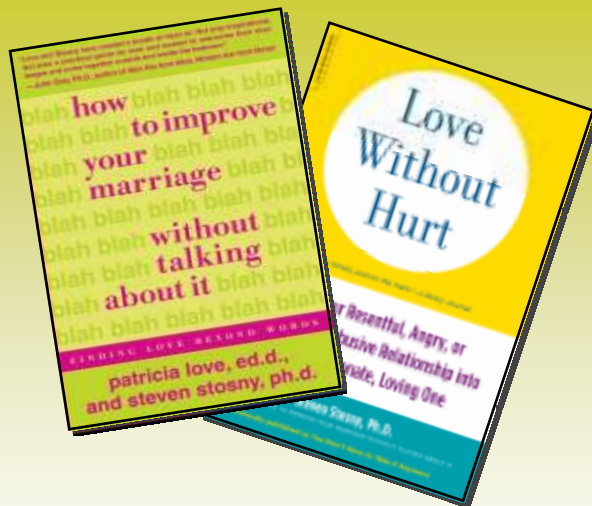

Helping Couples Fight "Emotional Pollution"

Steven Stosny, Ph.D.

Dr. Stosny will review recently discovered information on how emotions are transmitted almost continuously, in fractions of a second, and the implications of these discoveries for couples' therapy. He will then focus on how to use this new knowledge to help couples recognize the effects of emotional pollution (negative emotions downloaded from the environment) and work together to overcome them instead of blaming them on each other. The key to converting emotional pollution into meaningful, proactive expressions of love lies in self-regulation skill.
